The cauldron was commissioned for use in the Stoke Mandeville Paralympic opening ceremony for the Tokyo games. It will also be used in all future opening ceremonies at Stoke Mandeville for summer and winter paralympic games.

A key design feature is the almost full-length flame, which allows the cauldron to be lit from the bottom.
